Project Overview

The City of Oberlin seeks funding from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) for funding available through the Airport Infrastructure Grants (AIG) program for their Oberlin Municipal Airport Construction of Access Road and Parking Lot Project, which includes the construction of an access road and parking lot at the Oberlin Municipal Airport.

This opportunity is a formula BIL program with a local match requirement of 5% of the total project cost. The entity is requesting \$25,037.00 from the Build Kansas Fund, and is providing a local match of \$1,318.00. This request has the potential to unlock \$500,745.00 in federal funds, for a total project cost of \$527,100.00.

The deadline was April 28, 2025, and this Build Kansas Fund application was received on April 25, 2025.



- **4. Consistency with Local Plans** The project is reasonably consistent with plans existing at the time of submission of this application) of public agencies that are authorized by the State in which the project is located to plan for the development of the area surrounding the airport.
- **5. Consideration of Local Interest** It has given fair consideration to the interest of communities in or near where the project may be located.
- **6. Consultation with Users** In making a decision to undertake an airport development project under Title 49, United States Code, it has consulted with airport users that will potentially be affected by the project (§ 47105(a)(2)).
- 7. Public Hearings In projects involving the location of an airport, an airport runway or a major runway extension, it has afforded the opportunity for public hearings for the purpose of considering the economic, social, and environmental effects of the airport or runway location and its consistency with goals and objectives of such planning as has been carried out by the community and it shall, when requested by the Secretary, submit a copy of the transcript of such hearings to the Secretary. Further, for such projects, it has on its management board either voting representation from the communities where the project is located or has advised the communities that they have the right to petition the Secretary concerning a proposed project.
- **8.** Air and Water Quality Standards In projects involving airport location, a major runway extension, or runway location it will provide for the Governor of the state in which the project is located to certify in writing to the Secretary that the project will be located, designed, constructed, and operated so as to comply with applicable and air and water quality standards. In any case where such standards have not been approved and where applicable air and water quality standards have been promulgated by the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency, certification shall be obtained from such Administrator. Notice of certification or refusal to certify shall be provided within sixty days after the project application has been received by the Secretary.
